

PART SEASON CUP TIE SCHEME APPLICATION FORM

Season ticket holders enrolled on this scheme will have their* seats automatically processed for them and tickets posted to their registered address for all home cup games from January 2006, plus any home leg play-off games. However if you do not wish to attend the fixture you can return the ticket for a full refund of the ticket value excluding the £1 booking fee, as long as it's returned to the Ticket Office a minimum of 7 days prior to the fixture.

Please note the scheme will include all FA Cup ties played at home from January 2006, plus any home leg play-off game.

Terms & Conditions

The following conditions of issue are accepted when enrolled to the 'Part Season Cup Tie Scheme'.

- By becoming a member of the Part Season Cup Tie Scheme, the Club will provide the member with their season ticket seat for every home cup match at Molineux from January 2006 for the FA Cup plus any home leg play-off game during the 2005/06 season. The cost debited from a scheme member's credit/debit card will be at the ticket admission prices advertised for the relevant stand plus booking fee. Concession prices will apply to scheme members in receipt of a concession season ticket. There may be occasions when due to the location of the away support, season ticket holders in the Jack Harris Stand will be provided with alternative seating, this will be provided in an alternative stand and at the admission price for that stand.
- Dates of fixtures and the kick-off times are subject to change during the course of the season.
- Admission can only be gained by producing the relevant match ticket to the turnstile for each match. The Club cannot accept any responsibility whatsoever for tickets lost or destroyed. For lost tickets, please telephone the ticket office, but replacement tickets cannot be guaranteed.
- Membership of the scheme cannot be cancelled prior to the end of the season once a member has enrolled.
- Please note that once members are enrolled onto the scheme, they cannot opt out of attending any match due to be allocated. If members are unable to attend a specific match, they must wait until tickets are despatched in order for them to be returned for refund.

6. Members must inform the Ticket Office if credit/debit card details change. In the event of a card being declined or expired the Ticket Office will attempt to contact the member. It is the responsibility of the member to update the Ticket Office, because if payment cannot be processed, tickets will not be despatched and members will forfeit their chance to attend that match.
7. The face value of the unwanted tickets are refundable if returned to Wolves Ticket Office no later than 7 days prior to the fixture excluding the booking fee. Refunds are strictly not permitted on any unused tickets once the fixture has been played.
8. It is very important that changes of address are notified in writing to the Ticket Office well in advance of any house move. The club cannot accept responsibility for any tickets which go astray, and especially not as a result of a change of address. Tickets will be mailed to season ticket holders registered address a minimum of 14 days prior to the scheduled fixture, time permitting.
9. The Club reserves the right to withdraw and cancel membership to the scheme in the event of the holder being found involved in any incident of misconduct surrounding any football match.
10. If a scheme member forgets their ticket on matchday they will not be allowed admission.
11. There may be occasions when due to the anticipated attendance not every stand will be open. Should this situation arise scheme members will be issued with tickets in an alternative stand and at admission price for that stand.
