Supporter Code of Conduct

YOU MUST READ AND AGREE TO FOLLOW THIS CODE AT ALL TIMES. IF YOU HAVE PURCHASED TICKETS ON BEHALF OF OTHERS, PLEASE MAKE SURE THEY HAVE ALSO READ THIS CODE OF CONDUCT. THIS CODE IS DESIGNED TO HELP CREATE A SAFE AND ENJOYABLE ENVIRONMENT AND TO PROTECT YOU AND YOUR FELLOW SUPPORTERS. TO ASSIST CLUB STAFF PLEASE TAKE THE TIME TO KNOW WHAT IS EXPECTED OF YOU. IF YOU DO NOT COMPLY WITH THIS CODE, YOU MAY BE DENIED ENTRY OR ASKED TO LEAVE THE STADIUM.

Before purchasing a ticket, and again before attending a match, you must decide whether it is appropriate for you to attend, including careful consideration of associated risks and your vulnerability status. This will include consideration based on your own personal circumstances (including your age, group size and make up, health status and susceptibility to infection).

The Club cannot completely eliminate the risk of COVID-19. Therefore, if, you feel uncomfortable with the risk, you should not attend a Match.

You **MUST NOT** attend if:

- You or anyone else you are attending with has any Covid-19 symptoms and/or is required to selfisolate.
- Any other Covid-19 restrictions affect you which mean you cannot or should not attend.

You SHOULD:

- Aim to lateral flow test for COVID-19 on the day you attend a match.
- Consider wearing a face covering in crowded, enclosed spaces.
- Arrive in good time to go through all the necessary entry procedures and make sure you know in advance where your entry point is.
- Have your e-ticket loaded to your mobile device or have your print at home ticket to hand. Turnstiles will open 90 minutes prior to kick-off. Note: Tickets can only be used by the named owner of the ticket.
- Help reduce queues at security checkpoints do not bring a bag. If you must then only an A4 sized bag (21cm x 15 cm x 10cm) will be permitted into the stadium. Bags larger than specified, laptops and rucksacks are not permitted. There is no storage facility available.
- Be respectful to others in your vicinity by avoiding unnecessary close contact with people you do not know.
- Supervise any children attending with you and ensure they always follow this Code.
- Clean your hands regularly, you are also encouraged to bring hand sanitiser in a bottle no larger than 50 ml.
- Follow instructions from stewards or other staff to help ensure that the Stadium is carefully managed for everyone's safety.
- Contact your nearest steward if you feel ill or develop any COVID-19 symptoms while at the match.

Please BE AWARE:

- All payments inside the ground are contactless.
- If you engage in any conduct that is intended to transmit the COVID-19 virus you will be ejected from the stadium, the police will be contacted and you will be subject to the Club's sanction tariff potentially including a lifetime ban.
- All other terms and conditions and ground regulations will continue to apply and must be complied with.
