

Wolves Book of Remembrance



Thank you for your recent enquiry regarding the Wolves Book of Remembrance.

Listed below is information regarding the Remembrance Book and details of how to apply for an entry.

The book is housed in a glass case at main reception in the Billy Wright Stand at Molineux. The pages are turned daily so that they can be viewed by visitors. A professional calligrapher is commissioned to enter the messages in the book.

The cost of each entry is £30 payable to 'Wolves Aid' (A Wolverhampton Wanderers registered charity). We can also include an illustration of the Wolves Crest or Shirt next to your written entry for an additional fee of £10. Each inscription can be a maximum of four lines with 18 letters on the first line and 27 on lines three and four. The first line is the person's name with gold blocking decoration. The second line presents the dates of birth and death, with lines three and four reserved for a brief message.
