Ticket Allocation

We have been informed by Crusaders FC that we will receive an allocation of 541 tickets for the fixture.

We currently have approximately 22,500 season ticket holders and had approximately 19,000 members in the 2018/19 season. It is inevitable that due to the allocation of just 541 tickets there will be thousands of fans who have supported the club for a number of years, who will be unable to attend this match. We appreciate that this will be disappointing for several supporters.

Ticket Collection

Tickets must be collected in Belfast from Hilton Belfast Hotel on the First Floor, Tower Suite, 4 Lanyon Place, Belfast, BT1 3LP, between 9am until 6pm on Thursday 1st August.

Supporters will be required to show valid Photo ID such as a passport or drivers licence when collecting tickets, and the ID must bear the name of the ticket owner.

Tickets must be collected individually. Other ID or photocopies will not be accepted.

Travelling to Belfast

There are a number of frequent public transport options available to travel to Belfast, these include plane, ferry, coach and car.

On this basis, and due to the short notice of the fixture being confirmed, we will not be running any official travel to this fixture

Travelling to the Seaview Stadium

The Seaview stadium is located approximately 1.5 miles away from Belfast City centre.

Safe public transport links run regularly throughout the City of Belfast and the Stadium can be accessed by train, metro and bus from Belfast city centre

The ground entrance must be kept clear for emergency vehicles so there is no parking available at the stadium. Parking spaces are available alongside Shore Road and there is a free car park available

at a former warehouse site to the right-hand side of York Road which is a 2-minute walk from the stadium.

Wolves supporters will be located in the West Stand also referred to as the Fona Stand.

Wolves supporters will be required to enter via Turnstiles 1 and 2.

The stadium layout is printed on the reverse of the ticket and supporters are advised to check their ticket carefully before entering the stadium.

Searches / Prohibited Items

Before entering through the turnstiles, supporters will be subject to a search by a steward. Supporters are asked to arrive early to avoid any queues.

Bags will be allowed into the stadium but will be searched before entering through the turnstiles. Bottle tops will be removed from any drinks bottled brought into the stadium.

Prohibited items are the usual items as seen in the UK.

Disabled Supporters

Crusaders will be able provide 8 spaces for supporters who require use of a wheelchair and their carer

These tickets will be located in the West Stand and access will be via Turnstiles 1 and 2.

Recommended pre-match areas for Wolves Supporters

Wolves supporters are advised that the closest and best bars are in the Cathedral quarter of the city. There are also good bars for visiting supporters in the Botanic area and City Hall areas, including a Wetherspoons and Lavery Sports Bar which welcome football supporters.

Musical instruments will not be permitted in any bars.

Wolves staff will be on hand in Belfast ahead of the game to provide a ticket collection service. Wolves will also provide staff and stewards who will be located at the Seaview Stadium to provide a familiar face on the day of the game.
